Volunteers Needed!

#### What to have in your Pet's Emergency Kit

#### #1 Water and Food

Store a week's worth for each family member, including pets. Canned food keeps better, and your pet will be less thirsty if they get moisture from their meal. Remember can opener.

#### **#2** Medications and First Aid Kit

An emergency supply of any needed pet medicines. FA Kit can include gauze, wipes, peroxide, tweezers, antibiotic ointment.

#### **#3** Proof of Ownership

Use this 'Emergency Shelter Pet Passport' to keep pet specific information and *a picture of you with your pet*.

#### **#4** Proof of Recent Vaccinations

If you need to take your pet to an emergency animal shelter, a copy of their vaccination record will help ensure they get a spot.

#### **#5** Leashes and / or Pet Carriers

Utilize leashes and/or carriers to protect your pet from unsafe conditions common in severe weather or natural disasters

**#6 ID Tags** Have extra ID tags. Microchip in your pet and keep your contact information up to date.
