SHELTER REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the animal owner signed below, request the emergency housing of the animal being evacuated because of a pending or occurring disaster. **I must be housed at this shelter during my pets stay.** The animal owner hereby releases the person or entity who is receiving the animal from any and all liability regarding the care and housing of the animal during and following this emergency. The animal owner acknowledges that if emergency conditions pose a threat to the safety of the animal, additional relocation may be necessary, and this release is intended to extend to such relocation.

The animal owner acknowledges that the risk of injury or death to the animal during an emergency cannot be eliminated and agree to be responsible for any veterinary expenses which may be incurred in the treatment of their animal. It is also required that the owner or his/her agent take responsibility for the care, feeding and maintenance of their animal. **Check out is required when departing from the shelter.**

Western Mass Disaster Animal Response Team Standard Operating Guidelines

Bite & Scratch Protocol

Bites and/or scratches by pets must immediately receive medical attention and be reported to the proper authorities, who will supervise the response.

1. As soon as a bite and/or scratch is observed or suspected, place the suspect animal in a secure cage or crate that is clearly tagged:

“This cage / crate contains a pet that has been involved in a bite.”

- Isolate the caged pet.
 - No one is to handle this pet except professional staff that are specifically authorized to do so.
2. Immediately direct the person who has been bitten to medical attention.
 - As necessary, apply pressure to stop bleeding.
 - Wash wounds thoroughly with plenty of soap and warm water. Run water over the wound for several minutes to make sure it is clean and all soap is rinsed out.
 - After a thorough wash and rinse, apply an antiseptic solution, such as iodine or other disinfectant.
 - See a physician as soon as possible. If a physician of choice is unavailable, go to the nearest emergency-care facility. Explain how the bite occurred and follow the physician's advice.
 3. Determine and clearly document the incident in via the Bite Report Form.
 4. Make proper notifications.
 - If the bite occurred in the shelter notify the Kennel Team Lead, Shelter Animal Branch Manager and / or Safety Officer.
 - Notify the local Board of Health.
 - Notify the local Animal Inspector.
 - Notify the pet owner.

Standard Operating Guidelines**

Escaped Animal Protocol

To prevent an escape from happening in the first place is to:

- Pre-plan the shelter facility to mitigate any possible safety/security issues
 - Can the various species be separated in a secured area (separate rooms with doorways).
- Make sure all crate doors are securely latched
- Make sure all room and hallway doors are securely shut.
- Use personal protective equipment (PPE) as needed

Do not handle an animal if you are not comfortable doing so.

If An Animal Escapes

1. **IMMEDIATELY** blow your whistle using one long blast.
2. The shelter will immediately be lockdowned with exits staffed by the closest shelter work.
3. If there are clients in the registration area, the Registration Team will secure the registration area and have the owners and pets remain in the registration area until the all clear is sounded.
4. Kennel team members will act as a “capture squad” until the escaped animal is retrieved.
5. Once the animal is retrieved and returned to its crate the all clear will be sounded.

The “All Clear” signal will be two short blasts on the whistle given by the shelter manager.
